- BSBWHS413 Contribute to implementation and maintenance of WHS consultation and participation processes
- BSBWHS414 Contribute to WHS risk management
- BSBWHS415 Contribute to implementing WHS management systems
- BSBWHS416 Contribute to workplace incident response

The following entry requirements apply for the BSB50320 Diploma of Human Resource Management:

Entry to this qualification is limited to those who:

Have completed the following units (or equivalent competencies):

- BSBHRM415 Coordinate recruitment and onboarding
- BSBHRM417 Support human resource functions and processes

Equivalent competencies are predecessors to these units, which have been mapped as equivalent. OR

If you have worked in a HR related role, you can provide evidence to demonstrate the two (2) years' equivalent full-time relevant work experience to satisfy the qualification entry requirements.

In Addition, you must:

- Be aged 18 years or over
- Have sound language and literacy skills (at least Year 10 English, or equivalent)
- · Able to commit to the course duration and time commitment
- Learners must have access to a computer and the internet
- Must supply a Unique Student Identifier (USI)
- Have a valid email account and a telephone with a valid telephone number for learning and assessment communication, support session

Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) Skill requirements

Assessments
